

Editorial

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Dear readers,

It is an honor to present this interesting issue that closes the year 2017 and volume III of Sportis Scientific Journal.

On this occasion, a total of 13 manuscripts written by professors and researchers from Spain, Peru and Mexico are presented.

There are 12 original articles and 1 review article. Representatives of the Basque Country, Izaskun Luis de Cos, Gurutze Luis de Cos and Silvia Arribas Galarraga prepared the interesting article entitled "Physical activity and sport practice, associationism and intention of future practice in a group of adolescents aged 12 to 16 years". From the University of Extremadura, professors Silvia Pulido Pedrero, Juan Pedro Fuentes García and Ruth Jiménez Castuera offer us a research titled "Analysis of the relationship between motivational variables and anxiety in competing judocas".

From the Galician community we receive three manuscripts from the teaching staff of the three universities of Galicia: University of Vigo, University of Santiago de Compostela and University of A Coruña. Professors Laura Delgado Lobete and Rebeca Montes Montes approach the field of psychomotor skills with their article "Profile and psychomotor development of the Spanish child population between 3 and 6 years old", while the lecturers of the University of Vigo, Maite Abilleira González, Marián A. Fernández Villarino, Sara Ramallo Panceiro and Javier Prieto Troncoso present their paper "Influence of the Comparative analysis with other physical activities ". Finally, from the University of Santiago, professors Rubén Navarro-Patón, Silvia Basanta-Camiño and Cristian Abelairas Gómez publish the manuscript "Los juegos cooperativos: incidencia en la motivación, necesidades psicológicas básicos y disfrutar en Educación Primaria".

On the other side of the Atlantic, professors from Mexico and Peru send us two excellent works. Blanca Viridiana Alcantar González, Xóchitl Trujillo and Miguel Huerta wrote a book on body weight and blood glucose in Wistar rat of interest to coaches and sports technicians, while teachers in Peru, Ángel Anibal Mamani Ramos, José Damián Fuentes López and Moisés Efraín Machaca Quispe opted to publish an investigation on Physical Activity in school adolescents of the

Returning to Spain, we received a work by M. ^a Alejandra Ávalos Ramos, M. ^a Ángeles Martínez Ruiz and Gladys Merma Molina, from the University of Alicante, entitled "La disposición hacia la actividad física y deporte: narrativas de los adolescentes schoolizados". Very close to Alicante, professors from two Valencian universities, Irene Moya Mata, Laura Ruiz Sanchís, Julio Martín Ruiz and Concepción Ros Ros Ros, send us their research on the analysis of Primary Physical Education textbooks, called "Sports activities in the natural environment: their representation in Primary Physical Education textbooks".

From the centre of Spain, we received two manuscripts from researchers from the Community of Madrid. María Fernández Rivas and María Espada Mateos present their article with the title "Evaluating the attitude of physical education teachers towards students with Special Educational Needs" and Alberto Gómez Mármol, Bernardino Javier Sánchez Alcaraz Martínez and María Jesús Bazaco Belmonte publish the manuscript "Diversión en Educación Física en Educación Física en Educación Secundaria, sedentarismo y práctica de actividades físicaico-deportivas extracolegiales".

The issue closes with a review by Pablo Camacho Lazarraga and Africa Calvo Lluch of Seville, whose title is "A teaching strategy without errors for learning sports skills. A systematic review".
